We agree to indemnify and hold harmless Kingsmont Kids, Inc. dba Camp Kingsmont, Hampshire College, its owner, directors, representatives, and employees (“Releases”) from any and all liability of any nature for any and all injury or damage (including property damage, personal injury, illness, paralysis, and/or death) as the result of participation in the Kingsmont Kids, Inc. dba Camp Kingsmont summer camp program.

We further agree to waive any and all rights and claims for damages or injuries which I may suffer, either before, during, or after my involvement with any novelties or vendors brought onto camp. We will now and forever hold harmless all camp vendors and their agents.
